Announcing “31st Annual RI Open” Juried Exhibit

WCFA is seeking original works for our upcoming “RI Open Juried Exhibit” which will run from September 13 – November 2, 2017. This exhibit is open to all mediums and all subject matter and is a great opportunity to showcase current works being created by Rhode Island Artists!

Awards: Two “Excellence Awards” will be presented for \$200.00 each; 4 non-cash Honorable Mentions will also be presented. We reserve the right to add prizes if needed. Awards will be announced at the opening reception on Thursday, September 21, 2017 from 6-8pm

Eligibility: This show is open to artists working in all mediums who live in Rhode Island and students who are currently enrolled in undergrad or graduate art studies in Rhode Island. Works must be original, available for purchase, and completed during the last 12 months; previously submitted works will not be accepted

Entry Fee: \$15 for one image. \$40 for **up to** 3 images (2 or 3 images). Current WCFA Members and Students with current student I.D. can deduct \$5 from fees. Payments can be made by check (payable to WCFA) or by phone with VISA or MasterCard. All payments are non-refundable and due at the time of submission.

Hanging Requirements: All artworks must be wired and ready to hang; our hanging system does not allow for hanging with clips, saw tooth hangers, or loops – please wire prior to drop off.

How to Submit:

- Complete and email required “Artwork Submission Form” with JPEG images of artworks to exhibits@warwickcfa.org with “RI OPEN” in the subject line.(3 submissions max per artist)
- JPEGs should be labeled with the title of artwork only.
- An artist statement on the required “Artwork Submission Form” for the gallery book (200 words maximum)

Entry Deadline: Required “Artwork Submission Form” and JPEGs must be emailed to exhibits@warwickcfa.org by **Midnight on Friday, August 25.**

Notification of Acceptance: Friday, September 1 by 4pm

Artwork Drop Off Dates: Wednesday, September 6 (10am – 4pm) & Thursday, September 7 (1 – 6pm)
Installation: Friday, September 8

Pick Up for Accepted Work: Saturday, November 4 (12-3pm) & Wednesday, November 8 (10am-4pm)
(If you are unable to drop off or pick up during designated dates and times please contact Taylor.)

Art Sales Commissions: Artists receive a 60% commission on all original artworks and prints sold. Current Warwick Center for the Arts Members receive a 70% commission – to become a member visit our website!
